This powerful program not only aims to increase appreciation of our rich religious heritage, but also seeks to remind Americans that we must always trust in a higher power for guidance, protection and strength. The famous words of the program's title are, of course, taken from the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. One Nation Under God Month is observed annually during November.

The One Nation Under God project was adopted on July 30, 1964, by Exchange leaders seeking to heighten awareness of our rich religious heritage. November, observed nationally as One Nation Under God Month, is a special time of year when Exchangites join together to increase public appreciation of the important roles religious faith and freedom have played in our nation's history. This page contains a variety of simple but effective project ideas that will enable your Exchange Club to help remind all Americans of our religious freedoms. Also keep in mind that although November is One Nation Under God Month, these suggested projects can be equally effective at any time of the year.

## CTC Continued:

worldwide campus enrollment includes Classroom Enrollments of 105,415, Distance Learning enrollments of 62,420 and the Texas Campuses Enrollment includes 70,682 and Distance Learning enrollments of 43,182. Additionally there are 1,043 students in KISD and CCISD receiving dual credit enrollment. This enables these students to leave high school with their Associate Degree in many cases. The college is in good financial condition. Spring 2014 Tuition rates were \$66 per credit hour for in district residents, \$86 per credit hour for out of district residents, and \$194 per credit hour for Nonresident and International students. The college graduates 2886 in 2012-2013 school year and confirmed 548 certificates.
