Fund for Veterans' Assistance (FVA)

The Fund for Veterans' Assistance program awards three types of reimbursement grants: General Assistance, Housing4TexasHeroes, and Veterans Mental Health. All offer funding to non-profit and local government organizations to provide direct services to Texas Veterans and their families. The FVA does not grant funds directly to Veterans. Veterans in need of assistance are asked to visit the Grants Awarded webpage to find organizations in their area for information on receiving assistance.

General Assistance Grants

modification needs of Low-Income, Very Low-Income and Disabled Texas Veterans and their families. Such needs include, but are not limited to, the following: walkways ramps; doors, windows, and flooring materials; sliding doors; handrails and grab bars; bathroom modifications; and weatherization. TVC encourages all eligible applicants to apply for this funding.

Veterans Mental Health Grants

In 2013, the TVC and Department of State Health Services (DSHS) partnered to create the Veterans Mental Health Grant program to fund projects providing direct counseling and mental health services to Veterans and their families. Counseling services may include: Peer and group sessions; Veteran family member counseling; Equine therapy; Veteran Drop-In Centers; and Unique projects addressing Post Traumatic Stress and/reintegration for Veterans and family members.

FVA Funding Sources

The Fund for Veterans' Assistance General Assistance and Veterans Mental Health grants are funded through four primary sources:

- (1) \$2 Scratch-off Lottery Game;
- (2) Donations either online or by
