Mr. Will Brewster

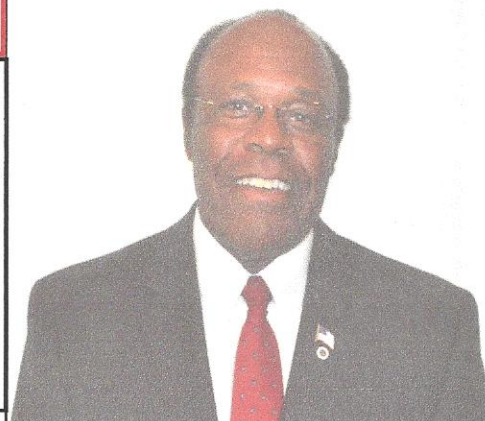
Director, Killeen Volunteers, INC
