

GET OUT THE VOTE PROGRAM

Purpose:

The Fifteenth, Nineteenth, and Twenty-sixth Amendments to the United States Constitution established the right to vote for all American citizens of minimum age 18. The National Exchange Club's Get Out the Vote Program gives our clubs the opportunities to not only remind their community members of their right to vote, but also their responsibility to vote. The Get Out the Vote Program is structured to encourage all citizens to exercise their right and responsibility by registering to vote and by voting for the candidates of their choice on election days or through absentee ballots.
